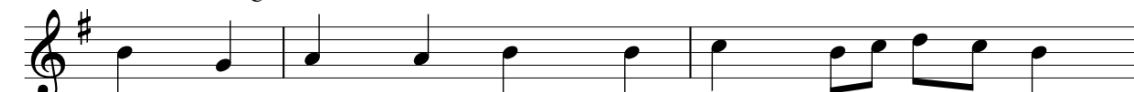

Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed
