#### The Reproaches

#### Response:

- 2. So will your ways be known upon earth and all nations learn your saving help. R.
- 3. Let the peoples praise you, O God; let all the peoples praise you. R.

#### (sing 1x only)

My People, what have I done to you? How have I offended you? Answer me!

- 1. I led you out of Egypt, from slavery to freedom, but you led your Savior to the cross. *R*.
- 2. For forty years I led you safely though the dessert. I fed you with manna from heaven and brought you to a land of plenty; but you led your Savior to the cross. *R*.
- 3. I planted you as my fairest vine, but you yielded only bitterness: when I was thirsty you gave me vinegar to drink, and you pierced your Savior's side with a lance. **R**.

#### Response:

Holy is God! Holy and strong! Holy immortal One, have mercy on us!

After Reverencing the Cross, Please sit or kneel

- 1. For your sake I scourge your captors and their firstborn sons, but you brought your scourges down on me.
- 2. I led you from slavery to freedom. But you handed me over to your high priests.
- 3. I opened the sea before you, but you opened my side with a spear.
- 4. I led you on your way in a pillar of cloud, but you led me to Pilate's court.
- 5. I bore you up with manna in the dessert. But you struck me down and scourged me.
- 6. I gave you saving water from the rock, but you gave me gall and vinegar to drink.
- 7. I gave you a royal scepter, but you gave me a crown of thorns.
- 8. I raised you to the height of majesty, but you have raised me high on a cross.

#### Response:

My People, what have I done to you?

How have I offended you? Answer me!




# Easter Vigil in the Holy Night



#### THE LUCERNARIUM



The liturgy begins out side. Frist the fire, which symbolizes the Light of Christ is blessed. Second the large Paschal Candle is blessed and lit. The Paschal Candle is then carried in procession into the church with the ministers and people following in procession with unlit candles. Once the candle has reach the center of the Church, the people light their candles.

The Easter Proclamation announces the Good News of Jesus' resurrection and triumph over evil.


