Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed

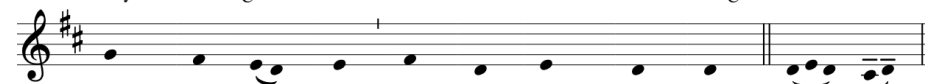

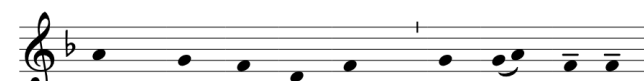
