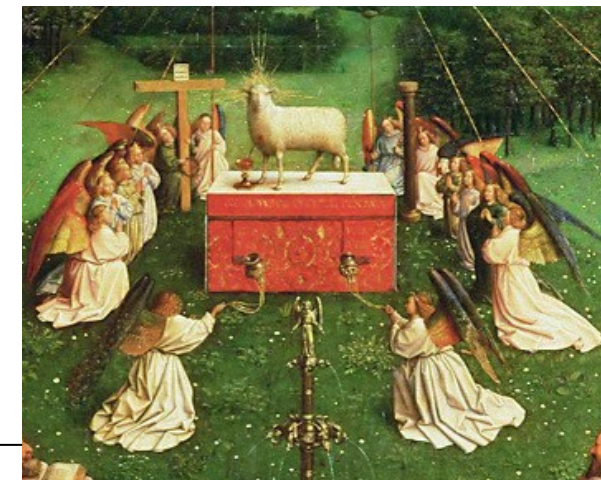

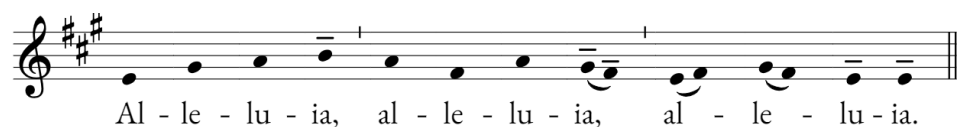

*Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed*

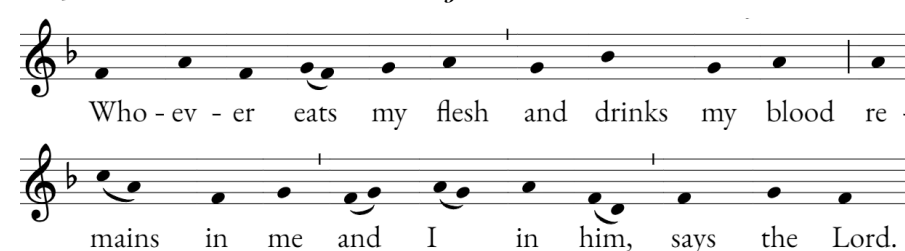
