ALL CREATURES OF OUR GOD AND KING

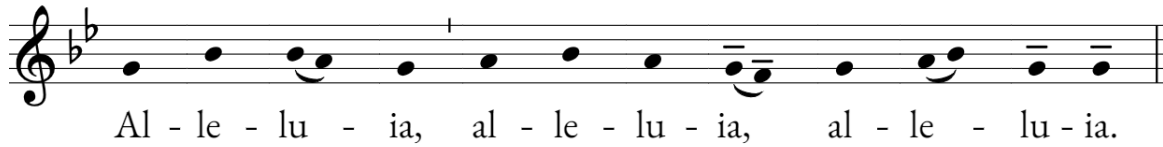
- All creatures of our God and King

### THE PROFESSION OF FAITH

*Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed*

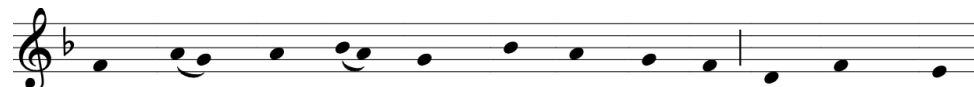
